Fusible/compatible glass COE 90 ONLY! Do not buy a large amount of any one type or color of glass to start with because you will tire of the lack of choice. Consider buying 1/2 to 1 sq. ft. Buy some clear, black and, iridescent and/or a small amount of dichroic glass. Some suppliers may have a starter glass pack of COE 90, which will include a selection of glass for a reduced price. It is difficult to estimate cost for each person as the projects can vary in size and price.
