2017 PHOTOGRAPHIC SCAVENGER HUNT

This contest is open to all photographers 18 years or older. Walnut Creek Center for Community Arts employees and family members, and employees and family members of sponsors or judges are not eligible to participate in this contest.

All participants must submit a completed copy of the Application Form to **Tom Crews, 5422 D Roundtree Court, Concord, CA 94521.**

Contestants will submit a total of 16 photographs taken during the time period of the contest (**June 1, 2017 – November 30, 2017**). All images must be current. Any images deemed to have been taken prior to this contest will be disqualified.

The contest consists of 16 different subjects:

A separate photograph must be submitted for each subject. The same photograph may be submitted for more than one subject.

All photos must be submitted in digital form by email, on a cd or on a memory stick. Emailed images should be sent to **xptom@comcast.net**. CDs and memory sticks will be returned on request. Images may be either in color or black & white.

- All images must be in JPG format (no larger than 5MB).

- Each image must be named with “Subject Number” and Photographer’s Last Name. For example, an image of “Leaves” submitted by Elizabeth Jones would be named “10-jones.”
Any images not named correctly will be rejected.

If mailed or hand delivered, all photographs must be received by Walnut Creek Center for Community Arts, 111 North Wiget Lane, Walnut Creek, California, 94598 or by Tom Crews (see address above) no later than **Close of Business on November 30, 2017** (regardless of post mark).

Winners will be announced and prizes awarded at the January 16, 2018 Photography Forum Meeting.

All winning entries will be displayed on the Photography Forum web site (www.xphomestation.com/PhotoForum/photoforum.html.)

Photographs will be judged by:

- How well the subject is represented
- Over all Composition, Exposure, and Focus
- Imagination and Creativity
- **It has to be a really good photograph!**

The decision of the judges will be final.

First, Second and Third Places will be determined for each subject. **The First Place Winners in each subject** will receive an 8x12 print with a hanger from **Magna Chrome** in Concord. **The Second Place Winners in each subject** will receive a tote bag from Walnut Creek Center for Community Arts.

The top two overall winners will be selected from the group of first place winners from each subject. **To be eligible for the Best of Show and First Runner Up Prizes one must have submitted an image for each of the sixteen subjects.**

Best of Show Winner will receive a 16”x24” framed print **Magna Chrome** in Concord.

Best of Show – First Runner Up will receive a **\$50 Gift Certificate** from Walnut Creek Center for Community Arts that can be used toward any Adult Class offered by CCA.
