

Drawing Class Materials- Elizabeth Selna:

- - One kneaded rubber eraser
 - - Staedler plastic eraser for pencil
 - - One of each of these graphite pencils (2H, HB, 2B, 6B)
 - - Pencil sharpener
 - - Charcoal: - vine and willow (soft)
 - - 2 Char-Kole brand square sticks compressed charcoal, (soft)
 - - 2 General's charcoal 4B & 6B
 - - Conté Sticks: Soft, white and black
 - - Newsprint pad , 18" x 24"
 - - Medium White Drawing Pad, 18" x 24" (Appropriate for ink, charcoal and graphite e.g. Strathmore Drawing)
 - - A sketchbook – 8" x 10" or larger
 - a chamois
 - toned charcoal or pastel paper, 2 pieces (tan, medium gray and black)
 - - Black India ink 2 oz
 - - 1 Dip pen nib holder with 2 nibs (tips), fine and medium)
 - -Watercolor or Japanese brush (size 6 or larger with a good point.)
 - -Recycled plastic container for water
 - -Black felt-tipped marker, fine point
 - - Inexpensive 12" ruler
 - - Any box in which to carry your drawing materials
 - - Drawing Board
 - - 3 large clips with which to keep the pages of your drawing pad from moving
 - -workable fixative for charcoal

- Optional:
 - - Painter's tape
 - - Apron (protects clothes from charcoal dust)
 - -Hand wipes for ink & charcoal
