



Expressive Watercolor Pamela Howett

Recommended Watercolor Paints:

- For my primaries I like to use:
 - Cadmium Yellow (W), Cadmium Lemon Yellow (C); Cadmium Red (W) and Alizarin Crimson (C); Cobalt Blue (C) and Cerulean Blue (W).
- Paper: Several full sheets of Arches #140 watercolor cold pressed paper
- Watercolor Brushes:
 - 2" Hake Wash Brush, one #12, #14, or #18 round brush, and old brushes to mix your washes.

Recommend: Pro Arte: Prolene Round Synthetic Watercolor Brushes.

- Palette: Any commercial, molded plastic palette with ample well size and a large mixing area. Most come with a lid which keeps pigment moist and offers additional room for mixing. Examples: the Robert E. Wood, Cheap Joe's Piggyback, or the John Pike Big Well.

Additional:

- paper towels
- sketch book
- drawing pencil
- kneaded eraser
- water buckets (2)
- Kleenex tissues (not scented)
- Plexiglas to paint on, larger than your painting.
