

## **Figure Drawing & Painting – Elizabeth Selna Materials List:**

These are suggested materials, please use what you have at home and supplement as needed. Supplies can be purchased at Michael's, Blick Arts and other stores.

**Surfaces:** canvas board, medium, (16" x 20" or 12" x 16"), watercolor paper, mixed media paper

### **Paints:**

**Watercolor:** mid-tone Red, (Grumbacher Red); Alizarin Crimson; Ochre; Burnt Sienna; Cadmium Yellow; Thalo Green; Cobalt Blue; Ultramarine Blue; Black & White. Watercolor (Reeves; Grumbacher, etc.) For students new to watercolor paint options: Kuretake Gansai Tambi Watercolor set or Reeves Student grade set.

**Acrylic Paint :** Same as above plus Raw Umber. And Matte medium, (e.g. Liquitex)

**Water-mixable oil:** Same as above plus Raw Umber. And Solvent Free Fluid, e.g. Gamblin)

### **Brushes:**

**Watercolor:** set of small medium & large rounds including #8 or #10 ) & flat wash brush

**Oil:** A combination of the following & bring what you have, (we will go over brushes on the first day) • Round style brushes small to large. Also experiment with Bright bristle brushes, Filbert bristle brushes & Flat bristle brushes, variety of sizes

**Acrylic:** 1½" basic brush; 1" & ½" Flat; #4 and #8 Filbert; #8 Round and #1 Rigger (detail)

### **Other materials:**

- Sketchbook, 9" x 12"
- Masking tape
- Palette
- Sponge
- Pencil & eraser
- Ruler
- Cotton rags/paper towels
- Plastic/glass containers for rinsing brushes
- Container for used turpenoid with spill proof lid, (glass jar, etc.) can be recycled
- Brush cleaner (Dawn detergent for synthetic brushes, Saddle Soap for natural brushes)
